## **Launching Ceremony and Workshop of ASEAN-ROK TVET for ASEAN Mobility (TEAM) Project**

**28 September 2020, Online Launch**

### **I. Background**

Towards enhancing human capital and workforce in ASEAN through technical and vocational education and training (TVET), ASEAN, together with the ROK, is undertaking the following three TVET-focused projects commencing in 2020, referred to as ASEAN-ROK TVET for ASEAN Mobility (TEAM) project:

- (i) Enhancing the Competitiveness of ASEAN Human Resources through Responsive TVET Curriculum Supported by Involvement of Industries and Labour Market Information;
- (ii) ASEAN-ROK TVET Mobility Programme, which include establishment of priority TVET sectors and programme, development of mobility tools on quality assurance and internship and faculty exchange and capacity building activities; and
- (iii) Assessment and testing of National Qualifications Frameworks (NQF) and Quality Assurance (QA) systems of CLMV countries within selected TVET programmes.

An online launch event is proposed to be held on 28 September 2020 to announce the project commencement and engage relevant stakeholders to discuss ways for stakeholders to get involved in project implementation and also create synergy. In light of the adoption of the ASEAN Declaration on Human Resources Development for the Changing World of Work and establishment of ASEAN TVET Council, the launching event aims to provide a platform for knowledge sharing on the advancement of TVET agenda in ASEAN.
