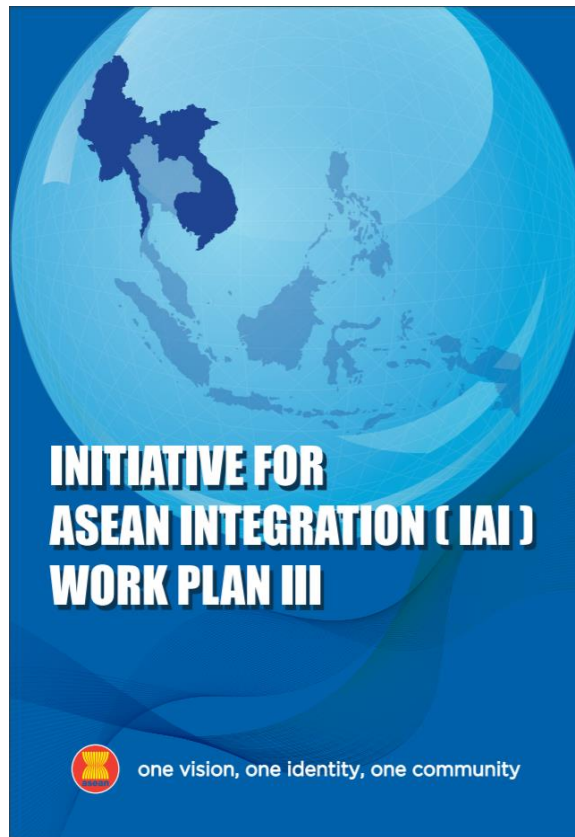

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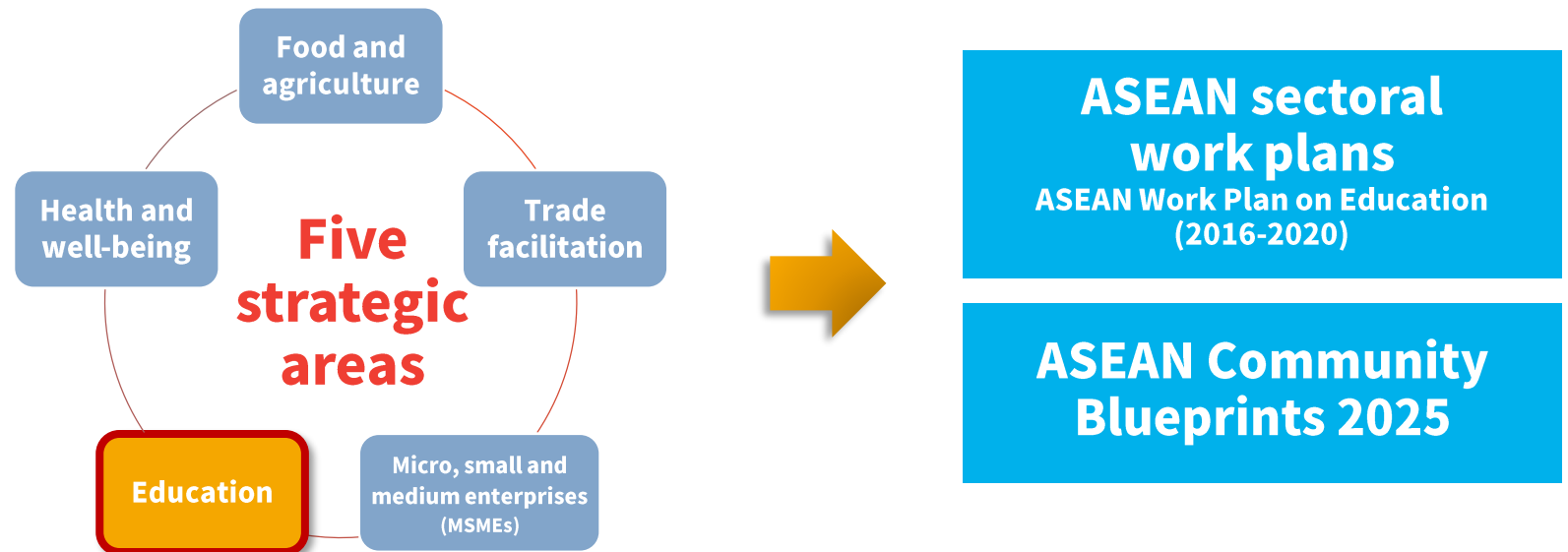

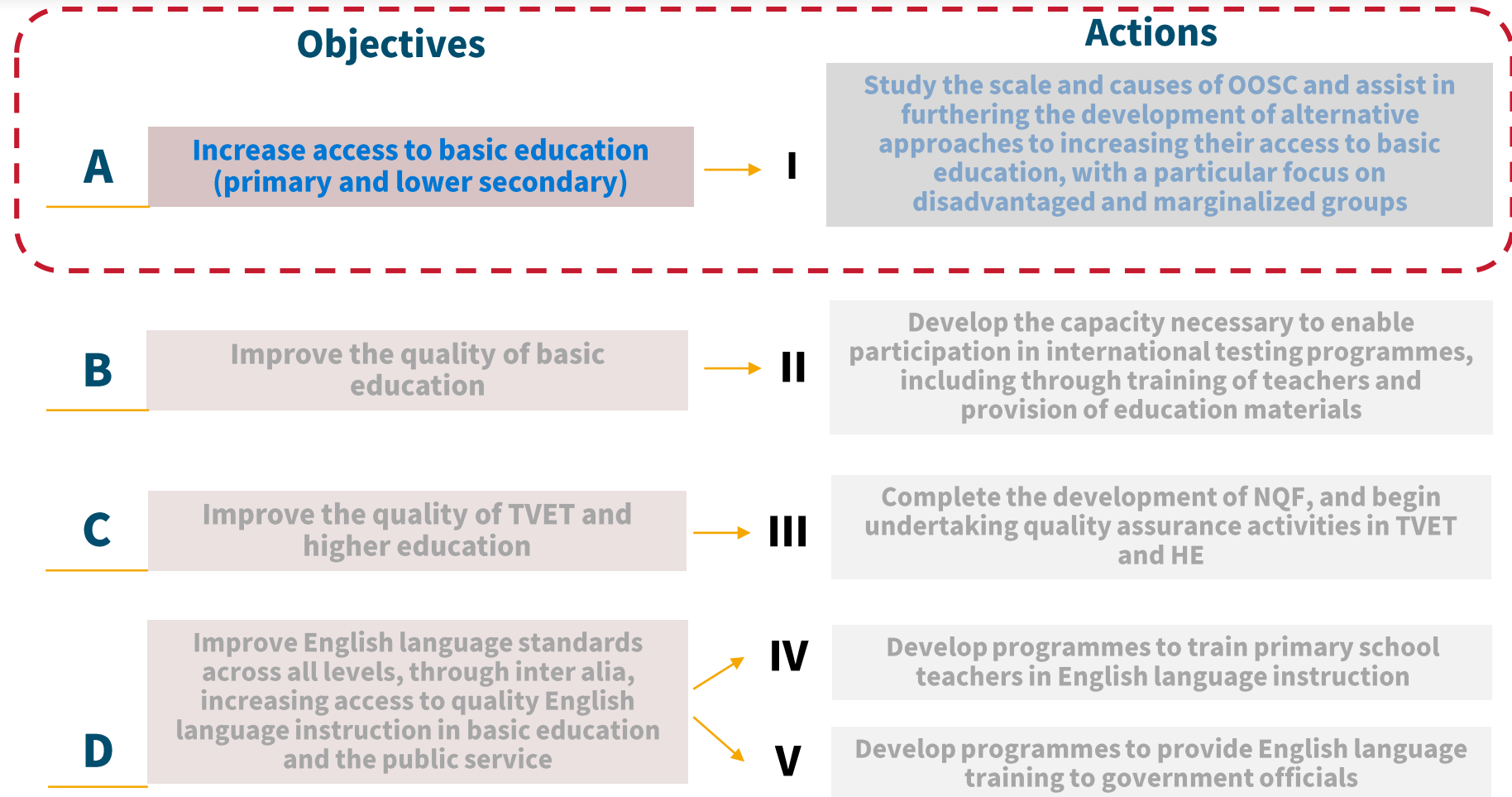
## The IAI Work Plan III (2016-2020)

- To assist CLMV countries to meet ASEAN-wide targets and commitments towards realizing the goals of the ASEAN Community

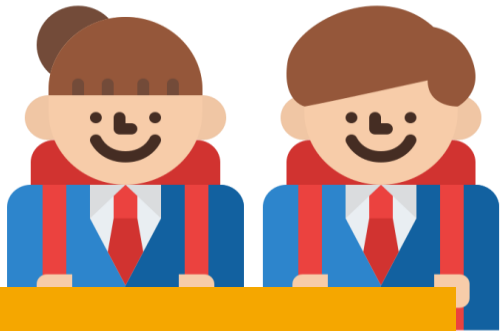

**ASEAN DECLARATION ON STRENGTHENING EDUCATION FOR OUT-OF-SCHOOL CHILDREN AND YOUTH (OOSCY)**

**WE**, the Heads of State and Government of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (hereinafter referred to as "ASEAN"), namely Brunei Darussalam, the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Republic of Indonesia, the Lao People's Democratic Republic (Lao PDR), Malaysia, the Republic of the Union of Myanmar, the Republic of the Philippines, the Republic of Singapore, the Kingdom of Thailand and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam, gathering hereby at the 28<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Summit in Vientiane, Lao PDR;

**REAFFIRMING** our commitment to the ASEAN Community comprised of three pillars, namely ASEAN Political Security Community, ASEAN Economic Community and ASEAN Socio-Cultural Community, as called for by our leaders at the 12<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Summit on 13 January 2007;

**REAFFIRMING** that one of the key purposes of ASEAN as stipulated in Article 1 paragraph 10 of the ASEAN Charter is to develop human resources through closer cooperation in education and lifelong learning, and in science and technology, for the empowerment of the peoples of ASEAN and for the strengthening of the ASEAN Community;

**REAFFIRMING FURTHER** the importance of education for children and youth and Article 31 of the ASEAN Human Rights Declaration which states:

- Every person has the right to education.
- Primary education shall be compulsory and made available to all through every appropriate means. Technical and vocational education shall be made generally available. Higher education shall be made available to all on the basis of merit.

**RECOGNIZING** that in parts of the ASEAN region, there is a significant number of out-of-school children and youth (OOSC) thereby requiring effective measures to enable them to have access to education and to benefit from continuous education and training, and to be retained in school (retention), and to complete such education (completion);

**COGNIZANT** that all Member States of ASEAN are Parties to the Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC), the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women (CEDAW) and the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD), and that the CRC defines a

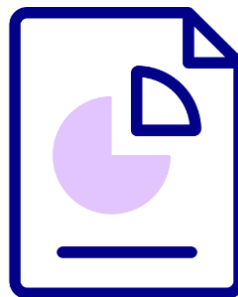

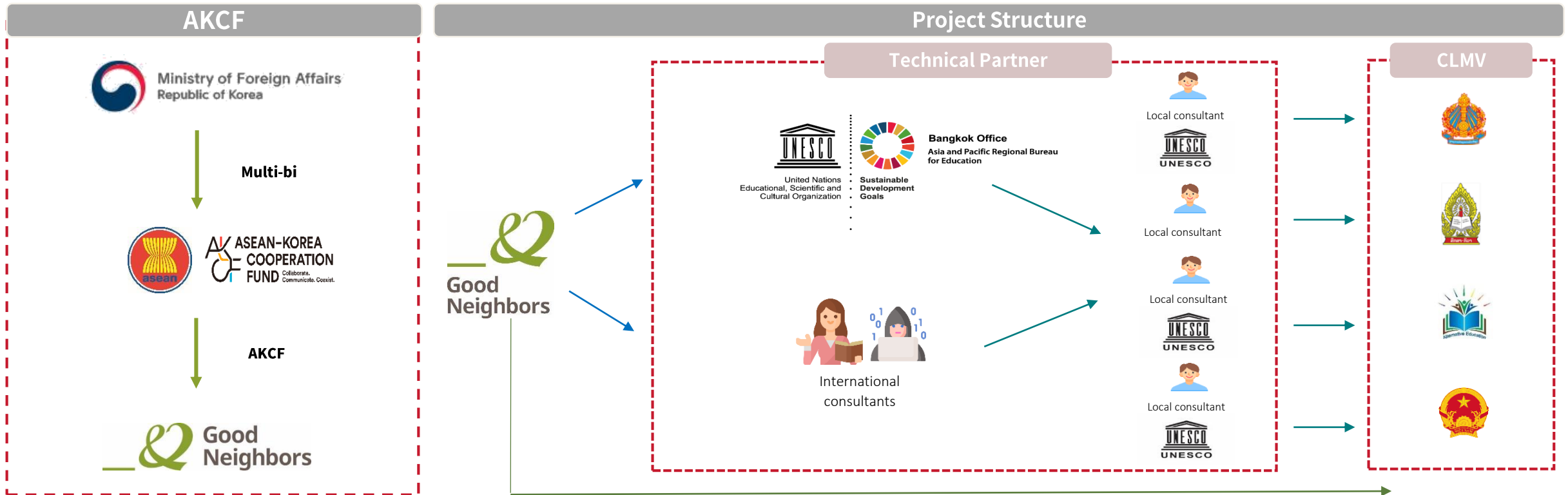
