The launch event in Langkawi, Malaysia on 31 July 2025, marked the start Malaysia's national implementation, the third out of targeted countries implementation. It was followed by the 1st MRC Meeting on 1 August, confirming the National Steering Committee on Climate Change (NSCCC) as Malaysia's official MRC, MyGhG with designated as its secretariat.

1st In-Situ Training Course on Critical Mineral Management

The in-situ training was designed to enhance the technical capabilities of government officials and experts from ASEAN Member States in practical geological exploration and integrated data management. It was held in West Java and Jakarta, Indonesia.

The training was implemented by KIGAM, as co-implementing agency of the project, with support from Coordinating Committee for Geoscience Programme (CCOP) and Geological Agency of Indonesia (GAI) as co-proponents.

From 25 August to 5 September 2025, 52 government officials and experts from across ASEAN took part in the ASEAN Smart City Professionals Program (ASPP) short-term training programme at Seoul National University.

This two-week training equipped participants with new insights on smart city planning and implementation. It combined classroom learning with field visits to Seoul and Jeonju City, giving participants first-hand exposure to smart city innovations in action.

Launch of ASEAN Secretariat's Electric Vehicles and Charging **Stations**

Jakarta, Indonesia, 8 August 2025 - As part of the 58th ASEAN Day celebration activities, Secretary-General of ASEAN, Dr. Kao Kim Hourn, together with the Ambassador of the Republic of Korea to ASEAN, H.E. Lee Jang-keun, officiated the launch of the ASEAN Headquarters/ASEAN Secretariat's electric vehicles (EVs) and charging stations.

The initiative is part of an ASEAN-Korea Cooperation Fund (AKCF)-funded project aimed at strengthening the operational capacity of the ASEAN Headquarters/ASEAN Secretariat's through the adoption of clean energy technologies. The ceremony was also attended by members of the Committee of Permanent Representatives to ASEAN. Prior to the launch, the ASEAN Secretariat also held a training for the drivers to familiarise themselves with the EVs.

Over the course of the project, a total of five EVs will be delivered to ASEAN Secretariat and five charging stations will be installed to support the EVs operation.
